Chair Gabriel Sandoval and Councilmembers

Chair Sandoval reported he attended a webinar on transgender employee rights sponsored by CRD and the EEOC. He also reported that he met with Chair Roybal and Vice Chair Salcedo of the Commission on the State of Hate in addition to CRD staff, Adam Romero, Rachael Langston, and Monica Chavez to discuss a future collaboration.

Civil Rights Department Executives

Rachael Langston gave an update on the California Civil Rights Department which included:

Councilmember Wilensky noted that the Council is proposing to make one change to the text and then enter a second 15-day comment period.

Chair Sandoval reported that upcoming Commission meetings will discuss hate incidents involving youth and social media, as well as the increase of hate towards elected officials.

Councilmember Hong asked about the frequency, locations, and schedule of the Commission meetings.

Councilmember Olude asked whether future Commission meetings will also discuss judicial officers.

Councilmember Glater asked about other concrete steps that would follow from the collaboration between the Council and Commission. Chair Sandoval discussed initial ideas raised at the meeting with members of the Commission.
