Pursuant to the requirements of Government Code section 11346.8(c), and section 44 of Title 1 of the California Code of Regulations, the Civil Rights Council (Council) is providing notice of the first set of modifications to the text of the proposed modifications of employment regulations regarding automated-decision systems. These changes are attached and made in response to public comments received during the 45-day comment period, which concluded on July 18, 2024. Although a 15-day comment period is typical at this stage of a rulemaking, the Council has the discretion to extend the period beyond 15 days (Gov. Code § 11346.8(c)) and has determined that this noticed comment period will last for 30 days from the date of this notice. Text proposed to be added for this comment period is displayed in double underline and yellow highlighting. Text proposed to be stricken for this comment period is displayed in double-strikethrough type and blue highlighting.
